The City of Omaha will hold a public information meeting to present information on three proposed projects along 24th Street.

The meeting will begin at 6:00PM with a brief introduction presentation by project representatives followed by an open house to review additional project information.

### About the Projects

Three projects are planned for 24th Street in South Omaha. A Complete Streets Safety Project would convert 24th Street, Leavenworth Street to 'L' Street, from a 4-lane roadway to a 3-lane section with the addition of a center-turn lane and bike lanes. A safety project at 24th & 'L' Street, would add a second left-turn lane for eastbound 'L' Street to northbound 24th Street. The 24th Street bridge over Interstate 80 (I-80) would also be rehabilitated.

The current designs would require the acquisition of new ROW, permanent maintenance easements and temporary construction easements throughout the project area. There are not expected to be any impacts to wetlands, endangered species, and there are no business relocations or residential home acquisitions. Impacts to historic properties and Section 4(f) properties are being considered, and comments related to historic properties would be taken at this meeting.
