



JONES STREET 11th-13th

THE NEED FOR IMPROVEMENT

Jones Street, from 11th to 13th streets, is in poor condition and is in need of repair.

- The project area was identified as in need of repair by the City's *2006 Historic Cobble Stone Brick Pavement Rehabilitation Study*.
- Project area residents, property owners, and businesses unanimously agree that the street and pedestrian accessibility must be improved.
- The project is currently scheduled for repair in 2020.

This project is planned to rehabilitate the existing brick roadway and improve sidewalk conditions while maintaining the historic nature of the area.

- The improvements are planned to include updating the roadway and sidewalks to current standards, including compliance with the Americans with Disabilities Act.
- Pedestrian and parking studies are planned to be conducted to inventory the current conditions and identify future improvements, including along 12th Street.
- Infrastructure improvements are planned to be completed, including new storm sewer inlets, storm sewer pipe connections, and utility repairs as needed.

Public input is driving the design of this improvement project.

- Project area stakeholders were consulted prior to the initiation of any improvement design work.
- The public will be informed and involved every step of the way.
- Community engagement and collaboration will ensure the final design meets the future needs of project area stakeholders and the entire community.
