


### PROJECT PURPOSE



 The purpose of this project is to reconstruct the intersection of 33rd and Hamilton streets in Omaha while minimizing impacts to adjacent properties at the intersection.

### PROJECT NEED



The need for the project is to remove an unwarranted traffic signal, improve safety and reduce travel speeds, and reduce the intersection crash rate.

#### **ENVIRONMENTAL CONSIDERATIONS**

- No impacts to trails, parks, wetlands, floodplains, or threatened and endangered species are anticipated.
- Due to temporary easements and the removal of one tree, there is a de minimis impact to a historic Section 4(f) resource.
- No adverse effects to Historic Properties are anticipated.





### ENVIRONMENTAL CONSIDERATIONS



- On-street parking is planned to be removed permanently.
- The intersection and sidewalks located within the project area would be closed during construction.



#### **ENVIRONMENTAL CONSIDERATIONS**




 Bus stop locations at 33rd & Hamilton Street would be impacted during construction.
