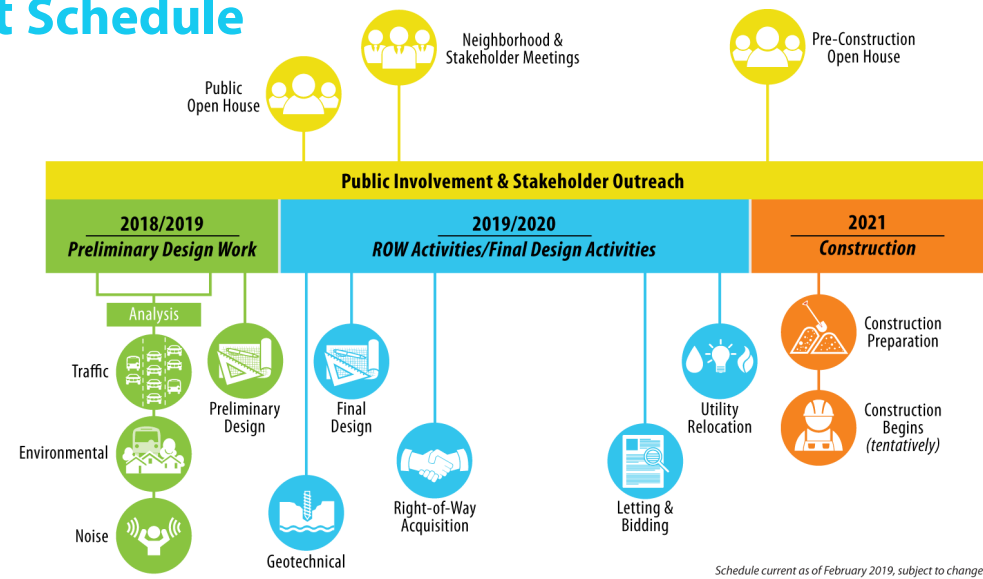
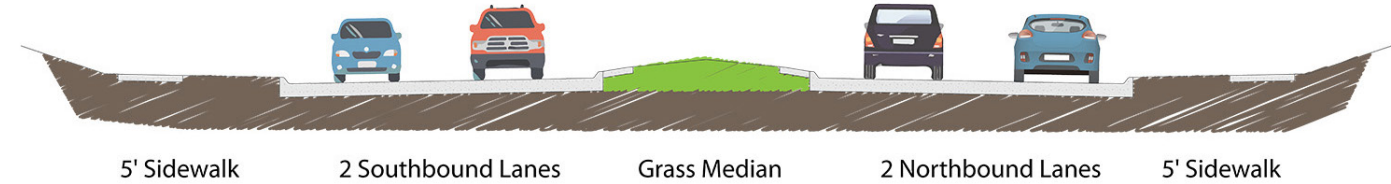

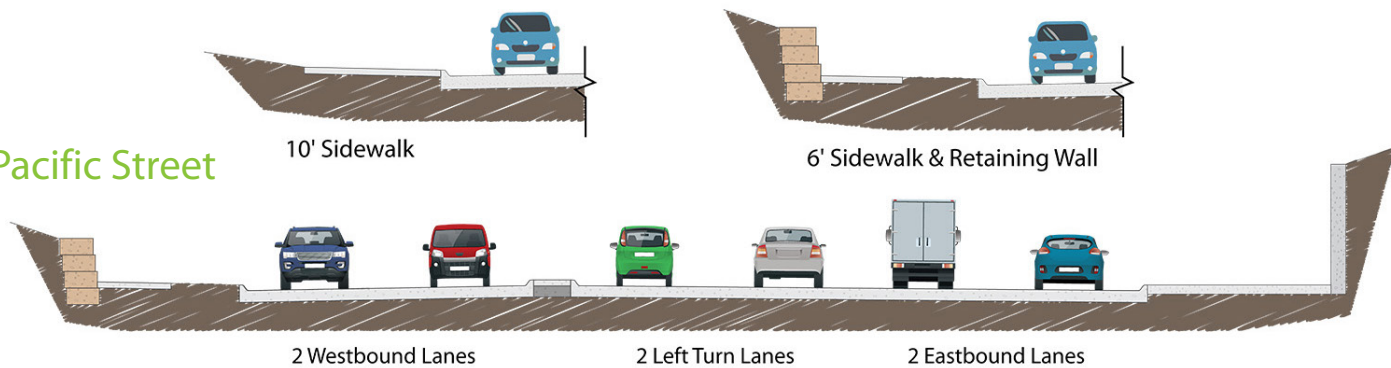


Typical Roadway Cross Section

The purpose of today's meeting is to present preliminary design and receive your input.

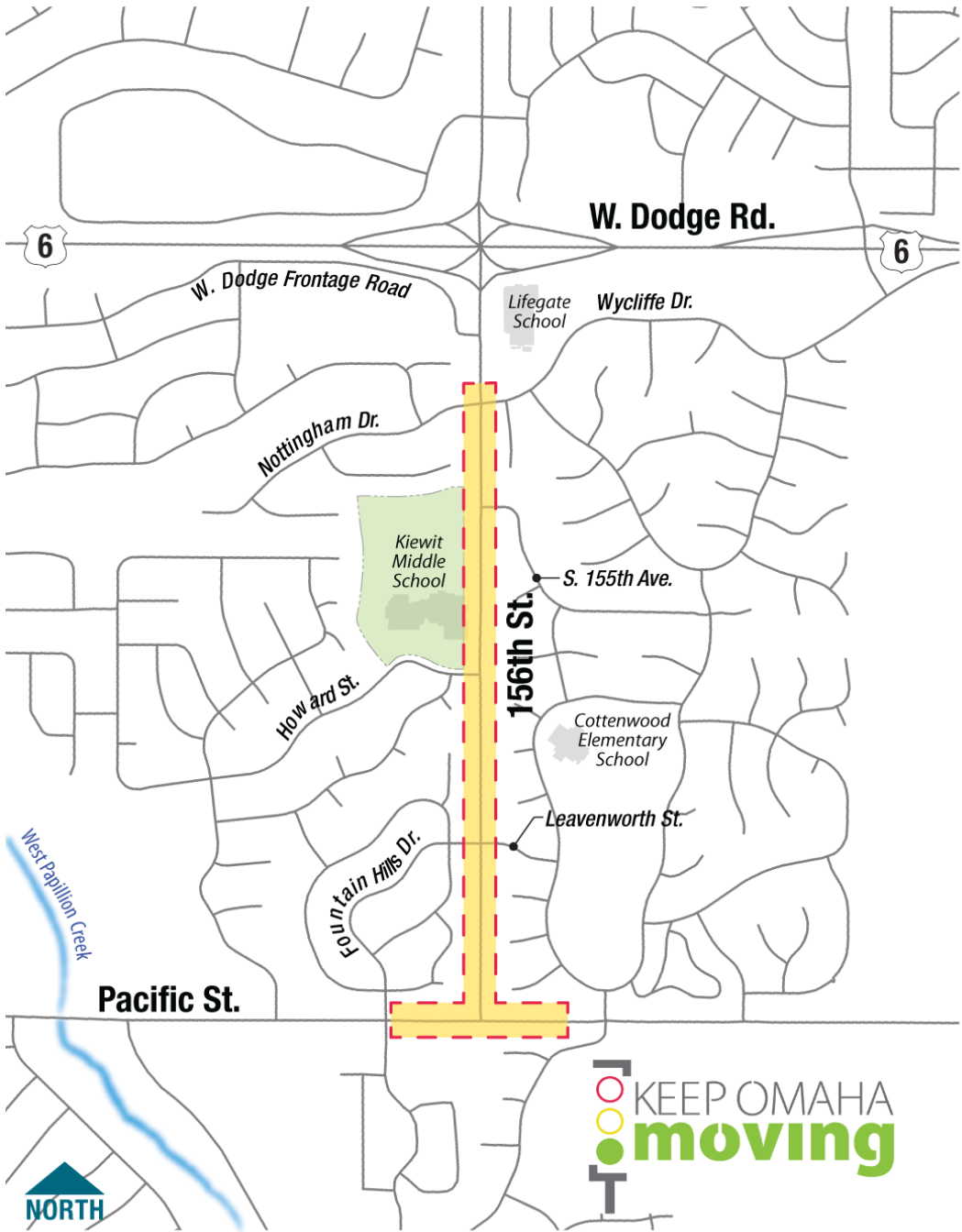
Project Background

The Proposed Project would widen 156th Street to a four-lane divided urban section beginning at Pacific Street and extending north approximately 0.8 miles tying into the existing four-lane urban section at Nottingham Drive / Wycliffe Drive. The project would provide additional turn lanes at the Pacific Street intersection and sidewalks along 156th Street.

- Improve Capacity
- Improve Safety
- Decrease Congestion

Construction Phasing

Every effort will be made to construct Pacific Street under traffic, maintaining one lane in each direction. 156th Street is still being evaluated to determine the best way to handle traffic during construction, options include a full closure during the summer months when Kiewit Middle School is out for summer break.

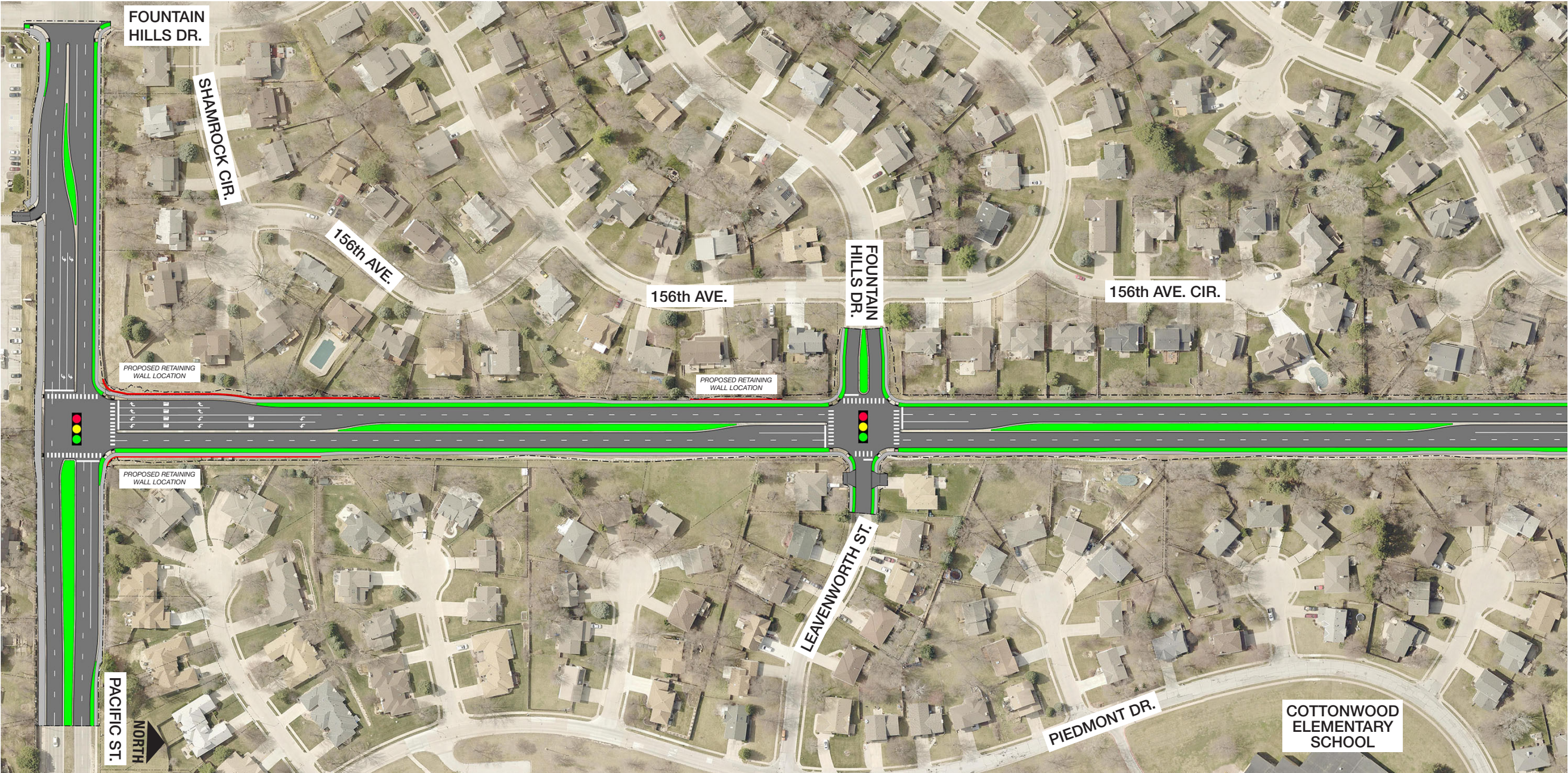
